Special Town Meeting Warrant – October 17, 2016

FRANKLIN SS:

To George A. Rice, Constable of the Town of Hawley, GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify and warn said inhabitants of the Town of Hawley qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Hawley Town Office in said Hawley on **Monday, the seventeenth day of October, 2016.**

At **seven o'clock in the evening** the meeting will convene to act on the following articles,

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to use \$345,165.39 reimbursed by FEMA/MEMA to make a payment against the Storm Damage Loan, or take any other action in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$104,834.61 from the General Stabilization Fund, or other available funds, to pay off the Storm Damage Loan, or take any other action in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the town will vote to rescind the General Bylaw for the Town of Hawley, entitled "Stretch Energy Code," which was passed at the Annual Meeting on May 2, 2016, a copy of which is on file with the Town Clerk, or take any other action in relation thereto.

This article has been put forward due to a misunderstanding at the last Annual Town Meeting about the number of votes that were required for passage. The Selectboard has voted 2 in favor, with 1 abstention, to recommend against passing this repeal.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof, one at the West Hawley Town Garage, one at the Hawley Town Office, and one at the Hawley Fire Station, fourteen days at least before time of holding said meeting.
