



Updated HAWLEY TOWN OFFICE COVID PROCEDURES



As the number of pandemic infections keeps falling and vaccinations keep climbing, Massachusetts is amending the state emergency regulations. And we are all hoping for the good news to keep on coming!

The Hawley Board of Health decided at their 5/25 meeting to rescind Hawley's Emergency measures which had been adopted on March 24, 2020, and June 9, 2020 respectively. However, the Board is continuing the mask requirement at the Town Office through June 30. Town meetings to conduct town business will remain hybrid (in person, with conference capability), until the state withdraws its municipal open meeting allowance for this option.
