Rabies Vaccination Clinic

Rabies Vaccinations: \$15 each

All dogs and cats must be on a leash, or in a crate, for safety. (Please bring prior vaccination history to receive a 3-year vaccine, if your pet qualifies. Otherwise, all vaccinations will be good for one year.)

Heartworm/Tickborne Disease Testing

4DX Test (includes Heartworm test): \$30 each

(This is a single blood test that tests your dog for the presence of three tick-borne diseases that have all been detected in western Massachusetts – Lyme disease; Anaplasmosis; and Ehrlichiosis. It also tests for the presence of Heartworm infection. You will be given a certificate verifying that your dog has been tested, and indicating the results.)

*Six month supplies of **Frontline Plus topical flea/tick preventative (\$85)** and **Heartgard Plus heartworm preventative (\$45-\$65 depending on size)** will also be available – while supplies last.*

Supplies are limited. All dogs and cats must be on a leash, or in a crate for safety. All are welcome to attend whether you live in Hawley or not.

Hawley dog licenses will be available at this clinic at \$5 per spayed/neutered dog and \$10 otherwise. It is not necessary to license cats in Hawley.
