GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. All work is to be done by skilled tradespeople. Proper Massachusetts certification is required.

 Minimum requirement is 3 years' experience installing systems of similar size and scope in Massachusetts. Permits are the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 2. The contractor will be bound by all applicable statutory provisions of law of the Federal Government, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and local codes. As the Town is exempt from the payment of Federal Excise Taxes and Massachusetts Sales Tax, prices quoted herein are not to include these taxes.
- 3. Prevailing Wage rates set at the Massachusetts Department of Labor and Industries apply to this bid. The pertinent tables in effect for this work are attached. Certified payroll must be submitted weekly to the Town of Hawley Town Coordinator.
- 4. All quotes must contain a properly executed Tax Compliance/Non-Collusion Form, and OSHA Statement. These forms can be found within the contents of this package.
- 5. A bidder will be held to the terms and the prices submitted for the duration of the contract period if a contract is signed by both parties within 30 days from bid opening.
- 6. The contractor will be required to sign a contract substantially in accord with the terms and conditions attached to this RFQ. Any questions or concerns should be raised with the FRCOG CPO before submitting a quote.
- 7. Contract execution will be conditioned upon producing an insurance certificate as outlined in #13.
- 8. The contract resulting from this bid will be awarded to the responsible and responsive contractor based upon low price, past performance and reliability of the contractor, quality of product and/or service, and degree of exclusion, exemption, or restrictions on the bid.
- 9. The Franklin Regional Chief Procurement Officer will be available to answer any general questions about procedure, etc., but no question will be answered that in any way could give an unfair advantage to a contractor. Inquiries should be directed to:

10. The Contractor must submit with their response a list of at least three (3) projects which they have successfully completed, giving the name and address of the projects so that they may be investigated prior to the award of the contract. Projects of similar size and scope in

Massachusetts are preferred. A contact person with CURRENT PHONE NUMBER must be provided for each reference.

- 11. Any inferior or damaged product, as determined by the Hawley Selectboard, will be replaced at the total expense of the Vendor.
- 12. Any restrictions, qualifications, or deviations from specifications must appear either on the Bid Form or on an attachment thereto.

13. **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

The Contractor shall at all times during the Contract maintain in full force and effect Employer's Liability, Worker's Compensation, Bodily Injury Liability, and Property Damage and General Liability Insurance, including contractual liability coverage. All insurance shall be by insurers and for policy limits acceptable to the TOWN OF HAWLEY and before commencement of work hereunder the Contractor agrees to furnish the TOWN certificates of insurance or other evidence satisfactory to the TOWN to the effect that such insurance has been procured and is in force

For the purpose of the Contract, the Contractor shall carry the following types of insurance in at least the limits specified below:

The TOWN OF HAWLEY shall be named as additional insured under the liability and automobile insurance. The general liability insurance policy should contain a broad form general liability endorsement.

Labor must be per MA Prevailing Wage, see schedule attached. Owner/Operators who are exempt from Prevailing Wage shall return with the bid a written statement attesting that they qualify for exemption. Any subcontractor is also subject to the Prevailing Wage law.

The TOWN OF HAWLEY, who is the awarding authority, is seeking price quotes from no less than three known qualified contractors per MGL Ch 149 §44A (2) (b). Other submissions may be accepted at the Town's discretion if they meet the qualifications and three quotes are not received from the three known qualified contractors.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

All brand names and models are suggested. 'OR EQUAL' systems may be proposed, but the Town has final discretion of whether to accept a proposed system as Equal.

MINI SPLIT

System shall consist of the following components:

- (1) Fujitsu Ducted Mini Split Heat Pump Outdoor Unit AOU36RLXFZH
- (2) Fujitsu Ducted Mini Split Heat Pump Indoor Units (1) ASU18RLF over entry way door and the same unit over the back side wall near entry
- (1) Pedestal / stand built or prefabricated to hold Outdoor unit and protect it from weather/snow

Installation and additional work

- Installation of all equipment complete turnkey install
- Carpenter shall build a hiding wall for the back of the unit with white flat board or white vinyl siding to match the building
- Run white slim duct
- Electrical box is 200 amp service with many open slots for breakers, basement accessible

Electrical Work – to be completed by Mass licensed Electrician.

All required permits are the responsibility of the Contractor.

Warranty

Warranty applies from the date of the final acceptance of the system. Minimum warranty is 5 YEARS covered parts and labor and 7 YEARS compressor.

Service

Bidder must offer service and install technicians for emergency service. Technicians must be certified for install and service of the Fujutsu systems or the system supplied.

ALL WORK IS TO BE COMPLETED WITHIN 60 days from execution of contract.

BEFORE the quotes are due, a bidder may request a change to the specifications/scope of work by sending the request as a WRITTEN QUESTION no later than one calendar week before the bids are due to bids@frcog.org. If the Town decides to make the change in Scope, an Addendum will be sent to all Bidders. This process is implemented to assure that bids are fair and based on the same Scope of Work.

NOTICE TO AWARDING AUTHORITIES

The enclosed wage schedule applies only to the specific project listed at the top of the schedule, and these rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project.

You should request an updated wage schedule from the Division of Occupational Safety if you have not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the enclosed wage schedule.

The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project for which it has been issued.

Once a contractor has been selected by the awarding authority, the wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract for that project.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

The enclosed wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site during the life of the project.

The wages listed on the enclosed wage schedule must be paid to employees on public works projects regardless of whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.

The enclosed wage schedule applies to all phases of the project, including the final clean-up. Contractors whose only role is to perform final clean-up must pay their employees according to this wage schedule.

All apprentices must be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprenticeship Training (DAT) in order to be paid at the lower apprentice rates. All apprentices must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours. WEEKLY PAYROLL RECORDS REPORT & STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

In accordance with Massachusetts General Law c. 149, §27B, a true and accurate record must be kept of all persons employed on the public works project for which the enclosed rates have been provided. A Payroll Form has been printed on the reverse of this page and includes all the information required to be kept by law. Every contractor or subcontractor is required to keep these records and preserve them for a period of three years from the date of completion of the contract.

In addition, every contractor and subcontractor is required to submit a copy of their weekly payroll records to the awarding authority. This is required to be done on a weekly basis. Once collected, the awarding authority is also required to preserve those records for three years from the date of completion of the project.

Each such contractor or subcontractor shall furnish to the awarding authority directly within 15 days after completion of its portion of the work, a statement, executed by the contractor, subcontractor or by any authorized officer thereof who supervised the payment of wages, this form.

- All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. - Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
